SUPPLEMENTAL/BID BULLETIN NO.2

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the issued Bidding Documents for the **Replacement of the existing Flight Information Display System (FIDS) at the Passenger Terminal Building**. This shall form an integral part of the said Bid/Tender Documents.

1. For this particular project, the Unix or Unix-based stated in the Technical Specification refers to Unix-like”.

“Unix-like is commonly used as a generic term referring to all operating systems that incorporate the major features of the early versions of UNIX, whether or not they officially call themselves UNIX or use the UNIX trademark. It is a broader term than Unix in the sense that the addition of the word- like eliminates any claim or implication that any system is UNIX (regardless of how UNIX might be defined or spelled”, and instead merely indicates that a system resembles the original UNIX systems”.¹

2. Please be informed that the Submission and Opening of Bids was re-scheduled on January 28, 2009 (Wednesday), 2:00 PM at the Clark International Airport Corporation, Board Room, Corporate Office Building, Clark Freeport Philippines. **Late bids shall not be accepted.** The reference for the time shall be the biometric system situated in the Corporate Office Building.
3. With reference to the Checklist of Technical & Financial Envelope Requirements for Bidders, the “Production Delivery Schedule” is hereby amended to read as “Schedule of Requirements”. As such, bidders are required to submit a copy of the Schedule of Requirements, found in Section VI of the Bidding Documents, duly signed by his/her authorized representative.
4. The document pertaining to Material Requirements indicated in the Technical & Financial Envelope Requirements for Bidders is hereby deleted. Hence, bidders are no longer required to submit this particular document.

CIAC reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to annul the bidding process and to reject all Bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders.
